In the Name of the State of Florida, to All and Singular the Sheriffs and Peace Officers of the State of Florida:


WHEREAS, a warrant was issued by this court on 9-8-14 for the arrest of defendant [REDACTED] upon a charge of violation of Probation; and


ORDER DISMISSING AFFIDAVIT
