DEFERRED PROSECUTION AGREEMENT

It being alleged that you have committed an offense against the State of Florida on or about December 31, 2018, to-wit: Trespass, and it further appearing after an investigation of the offense and into your background, that at this time the interest of the State of Florida, and your interest, will be best served by the following procedures:


**THEREFORE**, on the authority of Melissa W. Nelson, State Attorney in and for the Fourth Judicial Circuit, prosecution will be deferred for a period of seventy-five (75) days from this date, provided you abide by the following conditions:


- 1) You will not change your residence or move from the county of your residence without first notifying the State Attorney's Office.
  - 2) You will refrain from violation of any law, Federal, State or local.
  - 3) You will promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries directed to you by the State Attorney's Office. You will comply with all instructions the State Attorney's Office may give you.
  - 4) You will complete the following special conditions:
    - \* Pay a **State of Florida** fee of \$150.00. (This Program Administration Fee is payable online at SAO4th.com. Once paid, please provide a receipt of your payment to the SAO for documentation.)
    - \* Pay a **First Coast Crime Stoppers** fee of \$20.00.
    - \* 30 hours of community service work.
  - 5) PTI may terminate early upon completion of the special conditions and all charges related to your citation/arrest will be dismissed. **YOU MUST COMPLETE YOUR CONTRACT BEFORE YOUR NEXT COURT DATE.**
  - 6) Restitution: NA
- Other Special Conditions:

The State Attorney may, during the period of deferred prosecution, revoke and/or modify the conditions of your deferred prosecution by:

1. Extending the period of deferred prosecution.
2. Prosecuting you for this offense if you violate any of these conditions.
3. Voiding this agreement should it be determined that you have been dishonest about your prior record of criminal conviction, and/or
4. If the State discovers you have a criminal record that disqualifies you from participating in the program, you will be rejected from the program.


By signing this deferred prosecution agreement, the defendant FRANCISCO ALBERTO FERNANDEZ, withdraws and/or waives rights to a speedy trial Rule 3.191, Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, and in the constitutional laws of Florida and the United States of America in the cause for which prosecution is being deferred. Furthermore, by signing this deferred prosecution agreement, the Defendant withdraws and/or waives rights provided for under the Statute of Limitations under the United States Constitution, the Florida Constitution, Chapter 775 of the Florida Statutes, or the Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, in the cause for which prosecution is being deferred. This waiver is given freely and voluntarily.
